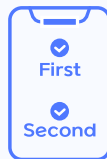


Please receive a booster dose of a vaccine for better protection against severe illnesses and deaths.

initial vaccination series

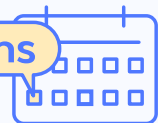

3 months (90 days) after the last  
COVID-19 vaccine dose

## Vaccine Type

① Teenagers aged 12 to 17:  
Pfizer bivalent vaccines

Omicron BA.1 BA.4/5

② Adults aged 18 and older:  
Pfizer or Moderna  
bivalent vaccines

## Vaccine Appointment

① Registered foreigners

Online, phone, same-day appointments,  
or walk-in visits

② Unregistered foreigners

Online, phone, or same-day appointments,  
or walk-in visits with a temporary  
management number issued from  
a public health center



## Note

**Online booking portal site** <https://ncvr.kdca.go.kr> (booking on someone else's behalf available)

**Same-day appointment** Call a medical facility to sign up for a COVID-19 booster vaccine wait-list

**Walk-in service** Visit a walk-in clinic and get vaccinated without an appointment or receive a vaccine while visiting for other medical purposes.

\* It is provided only when walk-in clinics have available vaccines and can deliver vaccinations without disruption to other health and care services.
